

School Verification and Test Administrator Forms

The Iowa, CogAT, Interest Explorer, Stanford, OLSAT; and short Iowa and CogAT/OLSAT practice tests can only be sold to private or homeschools. Click the link below to complete the School Verification Form. It must be completed each year. (The short practice tests do not require the administrator to have a B.A. or B.S. degree.)

The test publishers require the test administrator (proctor) of the Iowa, CogAT, Interest Explorer, Stanford and OLSAT tests to have at least a B.A. or B.S. degree. The degree can be in any field. You do not have to send us a copy of the diploma but must complete the Tester Qualification Form. (Click the link below for the Test Administrator Qualification Form). When you order with us, your signature or online agreement is legally binding. You should check www.hslda.org website to make sure that you can give the tests to your children in your state. In NC it is legal for a parent to give the above tests (if they have at least a B.A. or B.S. degree).

Schools and Support Groups

The test coordinator must complete the School Verification Form each year and the Test Administrator Qualification form for the group order. We do not need each test administrator form or each family's homeschool information. The test coordinator should keep that information in their files for 3 years.
